PFAS Statement

In collaboration with our supply chain partners, Confoil has undertaken a process to determine if PFAS has been intentionally added to any of the material, products, or substances we use or supply. APCO have stated that products with total fluorine, total organic fluorine, or extractable organic fluorine levels above 100 parts per million (ppm) will be considered to have intentionally added PFAS – any products under 100ppm will be considered as unintentional.

Working with our suppliers, Confoil has been testing materials and products to confirm that no PFAS is intentionally added to anything they provide. All testing has been completed via accredited labs (ISO Standard) and the test methodology follows one of three APCO established methods (PIGE, INAA or CIC). The following products have been identified as containing levels less than 100ppm of PFAS:

Baking Moulds - Eco-Parchment Paper	Less than 100ppm
Pulp Produce Trays - Wheatgrass	Less than 100ppm
Pulp Meal Trays - PET Lined Wheatgrass	Less than 100ppm
Board Lids – PET Lined Paperboard	Less than 100ppm
